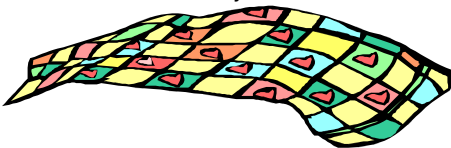

New Way Ministries provides shelter, counseling and tools to help women who need a place to stay and who often come with children. The length of stay depends on each individual and the needs they have. The families live at the center in their own room, sharing a kitchen with other families. The goal is to move them into the “Graduate program”.

Graduate Gals have gone through extensive training, classes and counseling. They have proven themselves to the Board that they are ready to move on into independent living and able to support their children. Each lady must complete 6 months at New Way and successfully meet all the requirements.

Daily Operations to run a program like this require many donated items as the women come with nothing but their children and sometimes only the clothes on their backs. They are totally dependent on the ministry to provide supplies to sustain life there until they are ready to move into independent living.

The *Women of Grace* have been supporting New Way Ministries for several years. And once again we have the opportunity to help them meet some of the needs of the graduate students as they move onward and also the general needs that arise in keeping the ministry afloat over the year. We are asking our church as a whole to help us meet these goals.

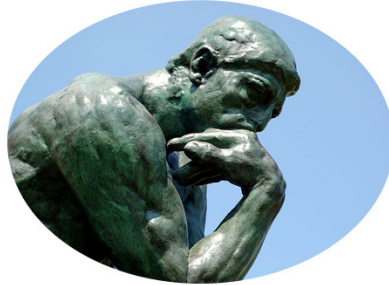
