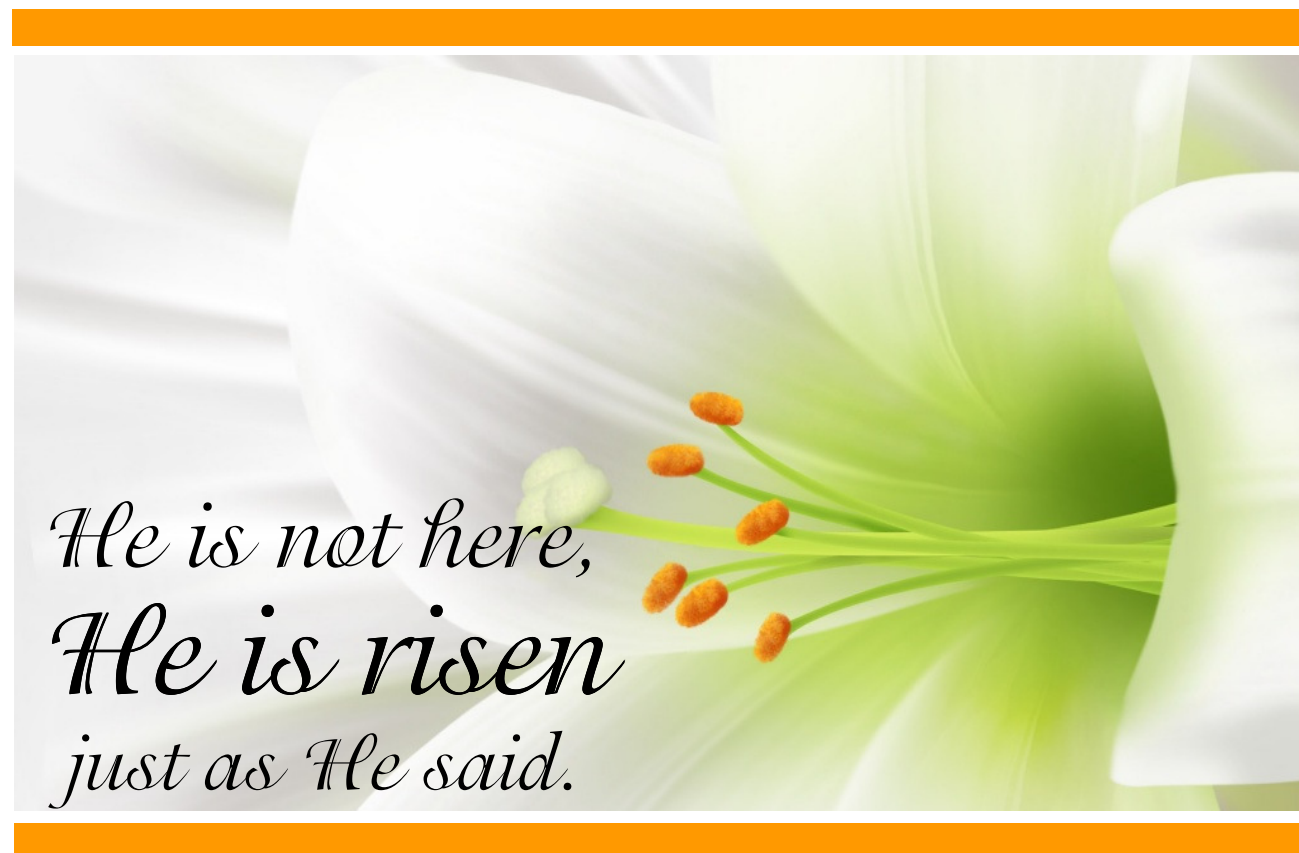

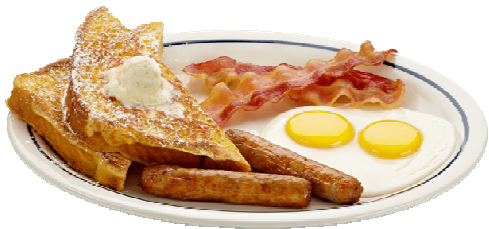
NEXT SUNDAY
