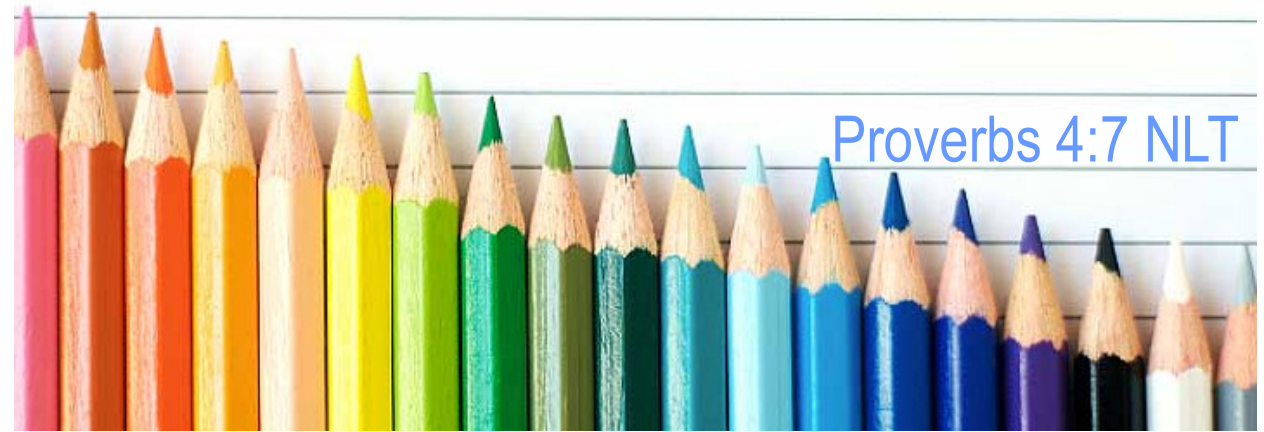

What We Do: New Way Ministries operates four programs to help families who are homeless or in crisis.

- **New Way Home** is for moms and kids. This is a 6 month structured program.
- **Next Steps** is a more independent apartment living program for graduates of our New Way Home.
- Our **Great Expectations** program is specifically designed to provide shelter and nurture for pregnant moms or moms with young infants.
- **Cottage Enterprises** is a line of handcrafted products we sell to help our moms with extra expenses such as legal fees, driver
