Wordsower Company is dedicated to speaking the Word of God into the Church of Jesus Christ, from memory and in faith, in North America. We also train and send out Scripture Tellers to this work. Our goal is to speak the Book of Revelation in all of the Church in North America as God enables.

Wordsower International encompasses all our Spirit-led and God-enabled work outside the U.S. These include orphan care, widow's ministry, endangered and handicapped children's ministry, anti-child trafficking efforts, church planting, pastoral training, printing, primary schools and two Bible Institutes. As of this writing we feed and house approximately 1,000 children, almost 300 widows and 1,100 churches in Liberia, Ghana, Sierra Leone, Cote d'Ivoire, Kenya, India, Nepal and Haiti.
